When Moses had finished speaking all these words to all Israel, ² he said to them, "I am now one hundred twenty years old. I am no longer able to get about, and the Lord has told me, 'You shall not cross over this Jordan.' ³ The Lord your God himself will cross over before you. He will destroy these nations before you, and you shall dispossess them. 
